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Introduction

Calculations of Chronic Absenteeism

Chronic absenteeism includes any student absent 10% or more of the time that he/she was enrolled in any school. Any student who misses 50% or more of a school day is considered absent. Chronic absenteeism differs from Average Daily Attendance (ADA), which is the average number of enrolled students who attend school each day. A school's ADA often masks issues surrounding the number of chronically absent students. A school can potentially have an ADA of 95% or higher while having a chronic absenteeism rate greater than 10%.

During the 2024-2025 school year, 120,408 Mississippi public school students were chronically absent compared to 107,266 students in 2023-2024. Mississippi's chronic absenteeism rate for 2024-25 is 27.6%, which has increased since last year. The Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) started reporting the rates in 2016. MDE first launched the attendance campaign in September 2018 to challenge students and school districts to strive to reduce individual absences to no more than five absences over the course of the entire school year. A statewide attendance awareness campaign was relaunched in June 2023 to encourage regular school attendance. Mississippi's campaign continues to be part of a national movement to reduce chronic absenteeism.

MDE formed a partnership with the National Dropout Prevention Center (NDPC) in January 2024 to address chronic absenteeism in the state. MDE Office of Compulsory School Attendance Enforcement and Dropout Out Prevention (OCSAE & DOP) held 12 regional training two-day trainings for individuals who serve in support roles for district teams. This two-day working event acquainted participants with the NDPC Strategic Process that is the guide for district and school teams to develop the highest-impact local plans for attendance improvement. Participants analyzed attendance data to determine the root causes of truancy, including an analysis of how the pandemic adversely impacted school attendance. Participants became familiar with and learned to help others use the most current research-based approaches to attendance improvement. NDPC provided participants with support documents, practice guides, and assessment instruments on both attendance and student engagement. The training focused on building statewide capacity to address chronic student absenteeism. Each participant received tools to train others to use identified curriculum modules in training and how to empower educators to transform classrooms to illuminate a path for students' success.

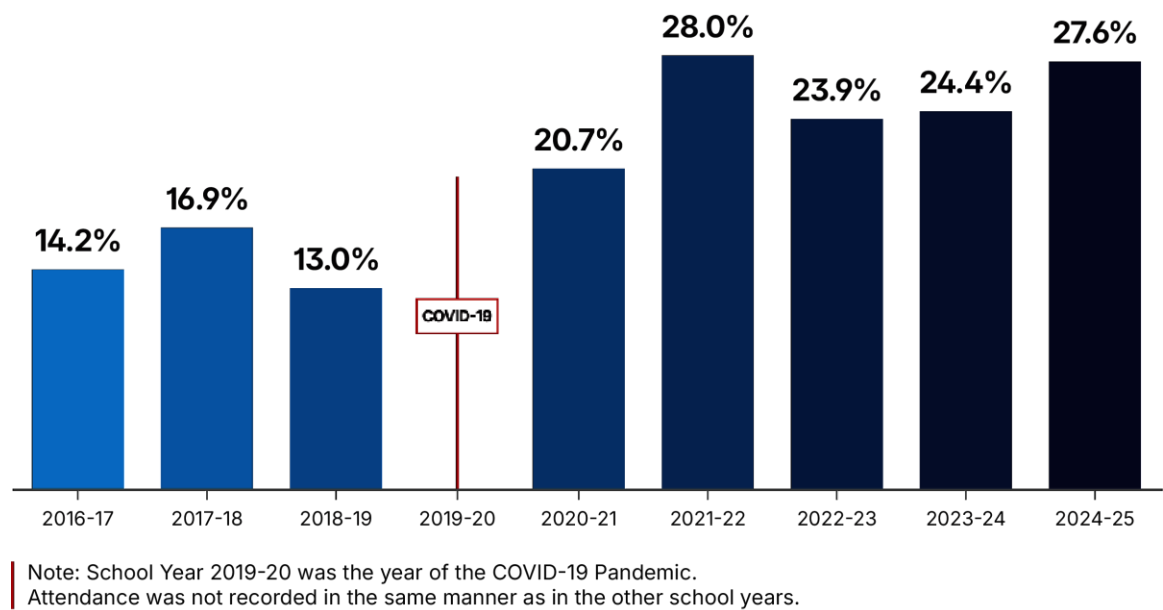
The intention of MDE is for districts and schools to use the NDPC training as a platform for sharing best practices and experiences, fostering a deeper understanding of how to address chronic absenteeism effectively. Moving forward MDE will continue to provide training to school districts and work with Community partners to address chronic absenteeism within the state.

The Mississippi Department of Education strongly urges all districts and schools to take immediate, proactive steps to combat chronic absenteeism. Here are specific actions that should be implemented without delay to ensure consistent student attendance and support academic success:

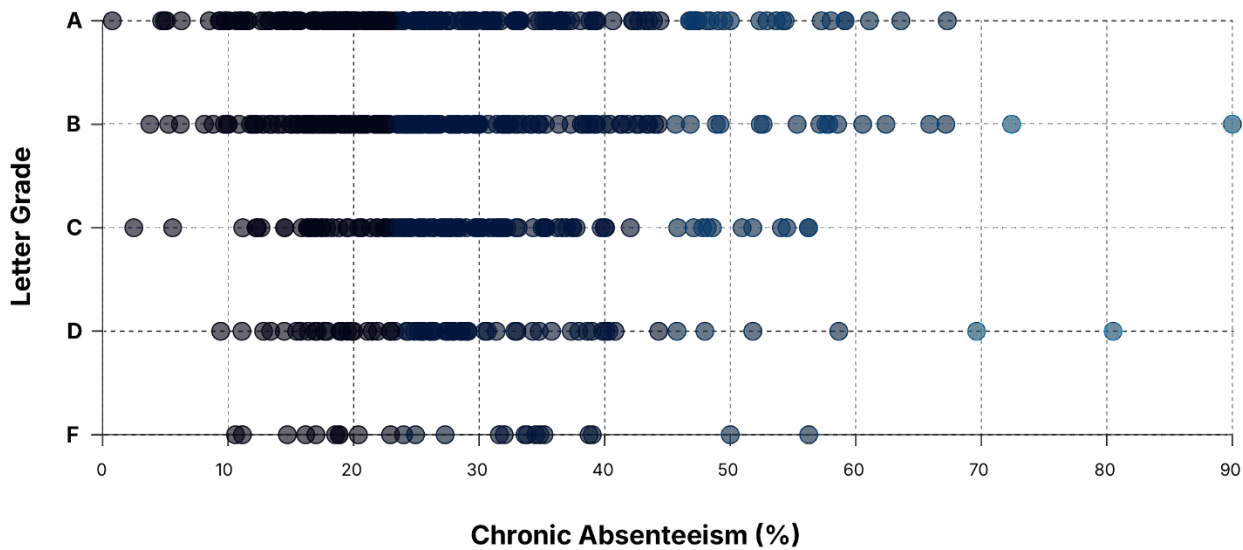
- Reduce student tardiness to reduce chronic absenteeism
- Use positive reinforcement to improve student attendance
- Promotion of school attendance at school sporting events.
- Connect attendance to the school “brand” (mascots, slogans, cheers).
- Create a mentor program.
- Consider an alternative to suspension.
- Engage students and parents
- Recognize good and improved attendance
- Develop programmatic response to barriers
- Provide personalized early outreach
- Monitor attendance data and practice
- Review [statewide policies for virtual learning](#) to be sure district policies align with state requirements.
- Work with your school and district data clerks to ensure accurate attendance data are entered.
- Encourage teachers and staff to make personal contact with families when students are absent. We know the power of personal relationships and how they foster a sense of belonging.
- Work with School Attendance Officers to identify and engage students who are at risk of becoming chronically absent.
- Review your health and safety protocols for minimizing the spread of infectious illnesses.

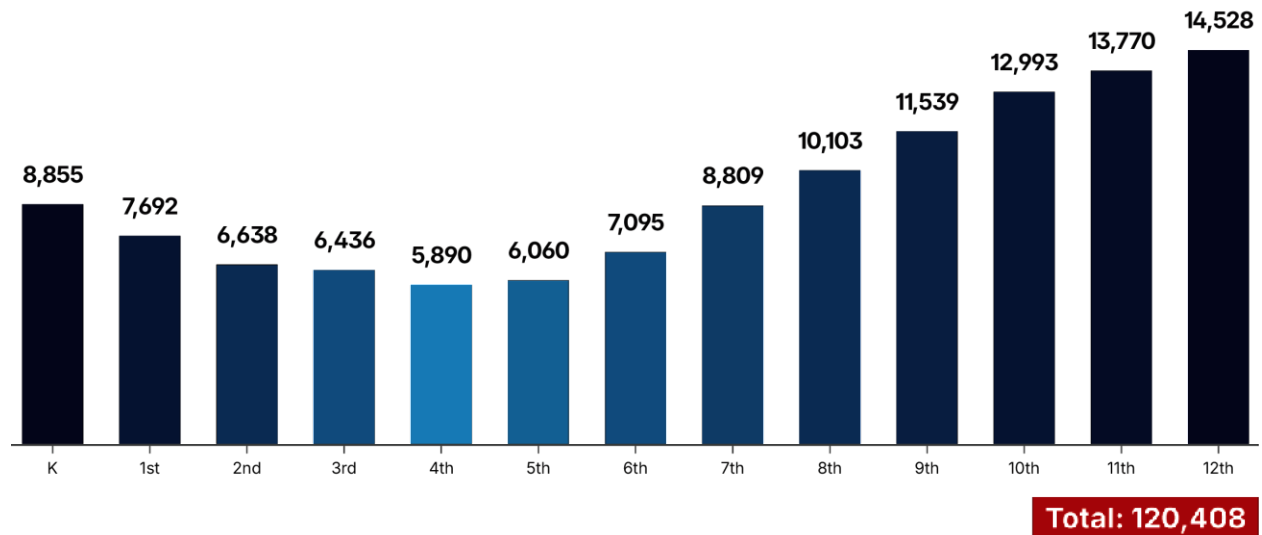
Chronic Absenteeism (%) vs Accountability Grade - Schools



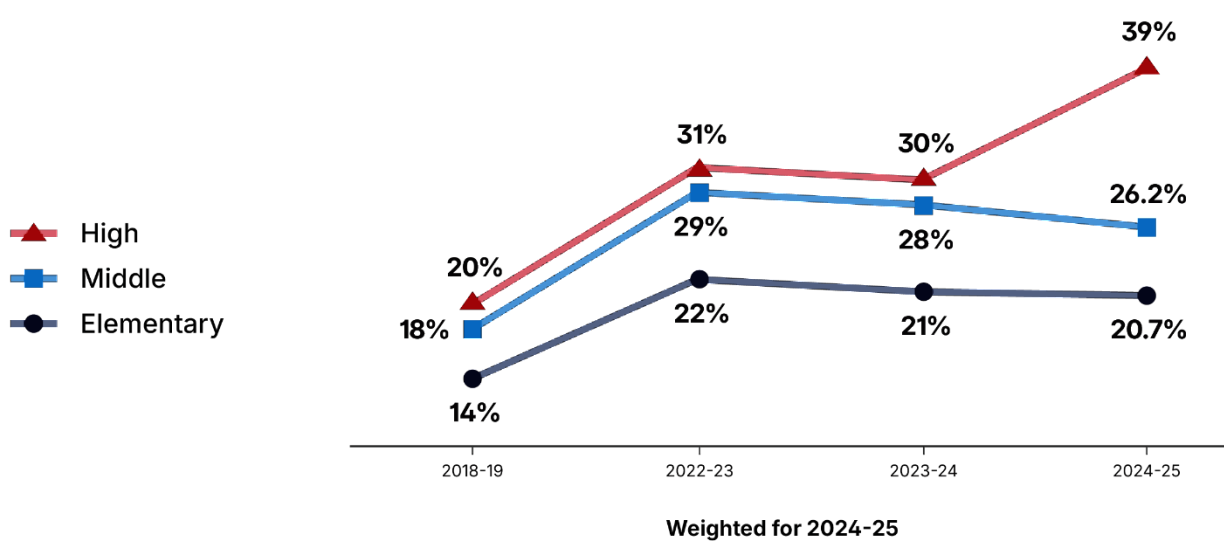

Chronic Absenteeism Rates by Grade

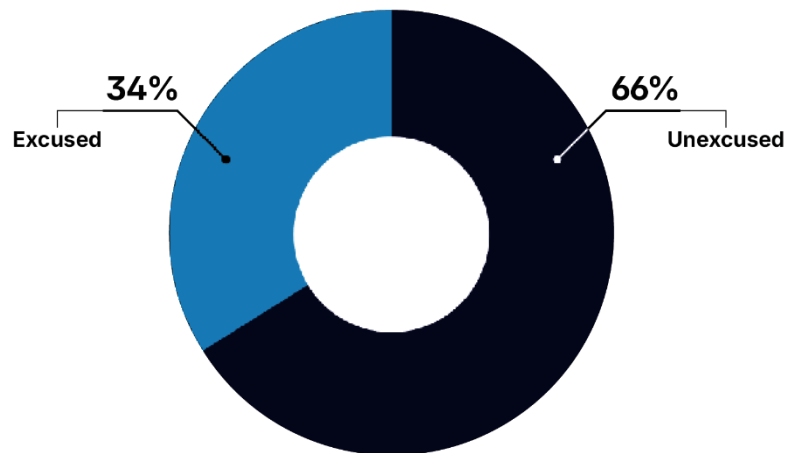
In the figure below, the data displays chronic absenteeism rates of each grade (K–12th) for total enrollment versus Chronically Absent Students.



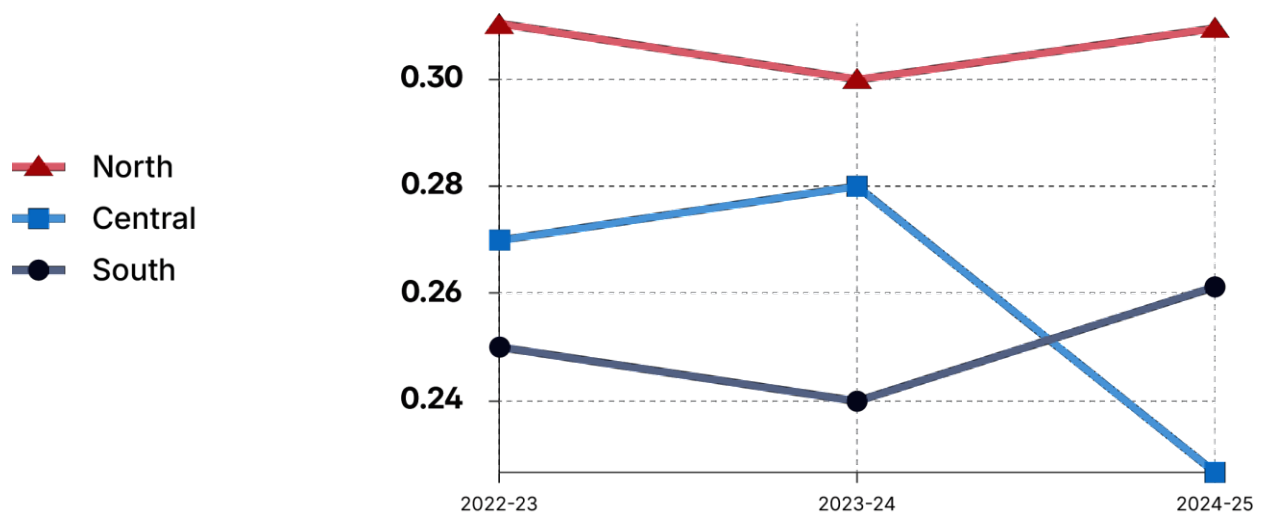
Chronic Absenteeism Rates by Grade Band

Chronic Absenteeism: 2024-25 Data Summary and Opportunities for Action

This report reflects an increase from the 2023–2024 chronic absenteeism rate; however, the detailed data and charts presented in this report reveal not only areas of concern but also promising signs of progress with respect to middle schools and elementary school decreases in chronic absenteeism and clear opportunities for targeted action.

Early grade data continue to demonstrate that strong attendance habits can be built when families are engaged early and consistently. Grades 2–5 exhibit some of the lowest chronic absenteeism rates, underscoring the effectiveness of early attendance campaigns and family outreach efforts. Approximately one-third of all absences are excused, most often due to health or family circumstances. This indicates that many students are not disengaged from school, but rather face situational barriers that can be mitigated through proactive communication, health partnerships, and family supports.

Chronic absenteeism is most concentrated in middle and high school grades, providing a clear roadmap for where districts should focus additional attention and resources. Across Mississippi, a number of districts and schools are leading the way with significantly lower absenteeism rates. Their success demonstrates that improvement is possible even in challenging contexts, and their strategies can inform and inspire statewide practice. Additionally, MDE intends to expand the use of data tools allowing more precise tracking of chronic absenteeism by grade and by district, empowering local leaders to design interventions that directly address their unique challenges.

While the statewide increase in absenteeism signals continued challenges, the data also affirm that the problem is not insurmountable. Early grade success (grades 2–5) proves that strong attendance habits can be formed. The high proportion of excused absences reveals that many barriers are solvable through enhanced support networks—such as school-based health services, mentorship initiatives, and family engagement programs. Concentrated areas of concern allow for efficient, targeted intervention, and districts that are already outperforming expectations show that meaningful improvement is both possible and replicable.

To reduce chronic absenteeism statewide, districts are encouraged to take several evidence-based steps: Engage families of students in grades K–3 through attendance messaging, mentoring, and recognition programs to reinforce positive attendance habits. Build partnerships with health care providers, provide flexibility for families facing extenuating circumstances, and establish outreach systems to re-engage students quickly. Implement grade-specific supports—such as advisory periods, peer mentoring, and career or technical pathway connections—to strengthen engagement among older students. Promote collaboration and the sharing of effective practices across districts to replicate strategies proven to reduce absenteeism.

Encourage personal outreach from teachers and staff when students are absent to communicate that each student's presence is valued and essential.

Mississippi's chronic absenteeism challenge remains significant. However, through focused strategies, early intervention, data-driven decision-making, and shared best practices, districts can make sustained progress toward ensuring that every student remains connected, supported, and on track for academic success.
